

## 10.15.1 Overview of the Upgrade Process on Windows Systems

- 1. Ensure your system complies with software dependencies and system requirements.
- 2. Back up OpenClinica.
- 3. Upgrade OpenClinica.
- 4. Configure OpenClinica:
  - 1. Ensure that OpenClinica is configured for optimum performance as described here: Configure OpenClinica for Optimum Performance.
  - 2. You may also need to configure OpenClinica for internationalization should you wish to utilize OpenClinica in different languages. Also, if you need to use some UTF-8 characters in your application, you may need to modify your default connecter configuration. - 5. Verify the upgrade.
- 6. Make manual updates to the database. The instructions are the same as for upgrading OpenClinica on Linux systems, except the README file on Windows systems is located at: c:ocinstallOpenClinica-v.x.yconfigdatabasesPostgreSQL
