

12.2.1 Creating a Bulleted List

A bulleted list is created using the HTML tag. Each element in the list is separated using the tag. For example, the following code

List TitleItem1Item2

will create the following...

List Title

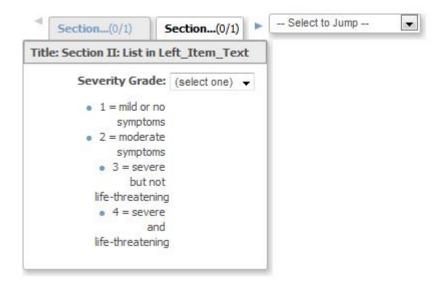
- Item1
- Item2

A bulleted list can be inserted into the Left Item Text, Right Item Text, Header, or Instructions. Theoretically, a bulleted list could exist in the Subheader, but the Subheader can only contain up to 240 characters, resulting in a very short list.

12.2.1.1 Additional Tips

Adding a bulleted list to the Left Item Text may result in spacing issues, as shown below.



JQuery can be used to avoid a spacing issue. The following JQuery, when added to the Instructions column of the Section, will increase the width of the Left Item Text and set the text to left-alignment:

<style type="text/css">.aka text block{width:200px;text-align:left;}</style>

After making this chance, the list is much easier to read:
