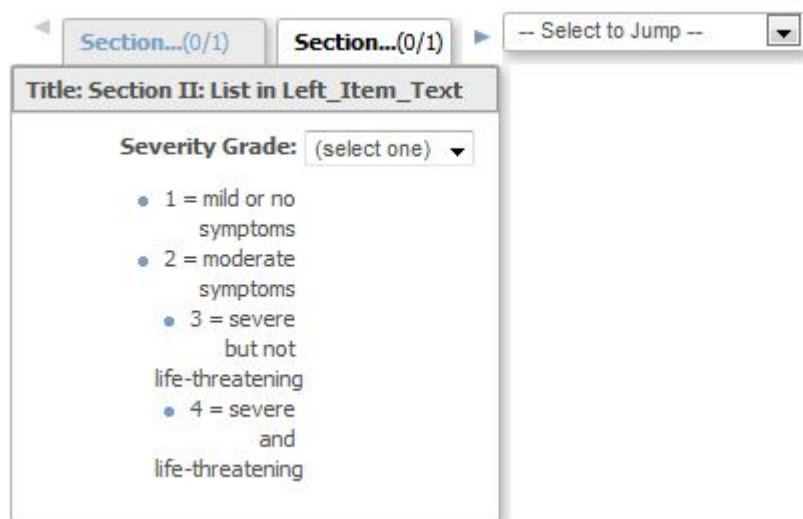


12.2.1.1 Additional Tips

Adding a bulleted list to the Left Item Text may result in spacing issues, as shown below.

After making this change, the list is much easier to read:
